The OSHC Foundation is a United States nonprofit corporation which is a 501 (c) (3) organization. It was founded in 2001 by a group of hunters who formed a club in South Africa which became dedicated to support the needs of African school children and their communities. Since their founding, the U.S. Foundation and its South African non-profit affiliate have expanded their programs to include the distribution of wheel chairs, hearing aids, text books and financial support for selected schools and communities. They have partnered with trusted South African individuals and organizations in order to develop procedures to select the appropriate individuals and communities requiring support and to locally manage their charitable programs. To-date, the value of the goods and funds distributed to needy African schools, organizations and individuals exceeds \$700,000 dollars.
